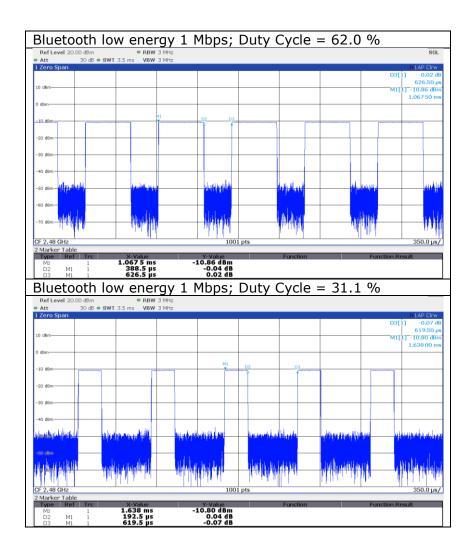

The results recorded were measured with the modulation which produce the worst-case (smallest) emission bandwidth.

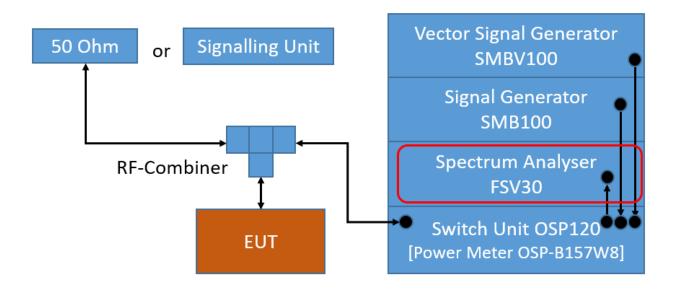

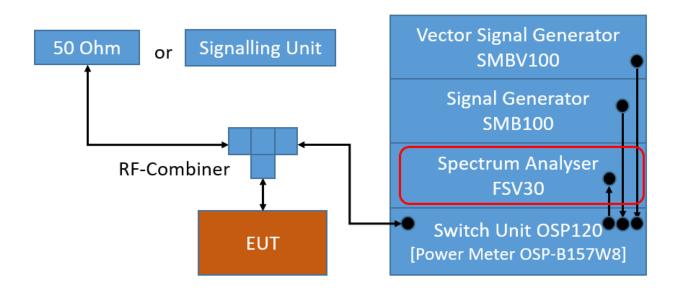

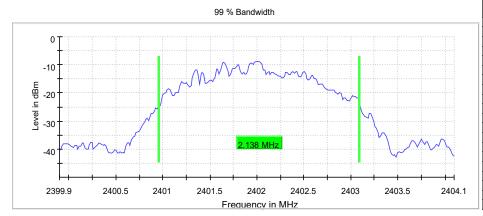

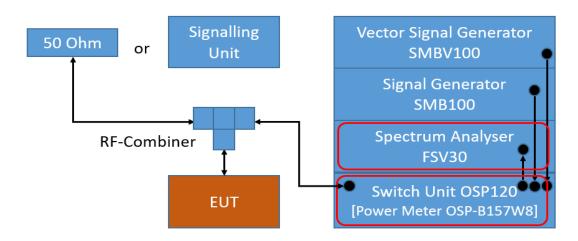

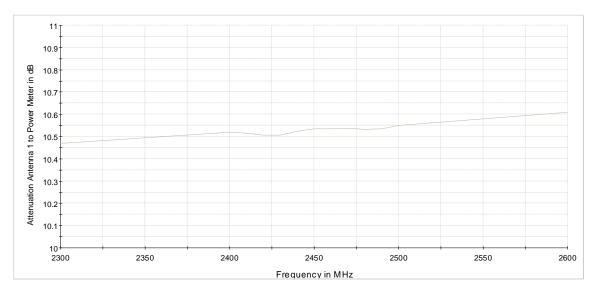

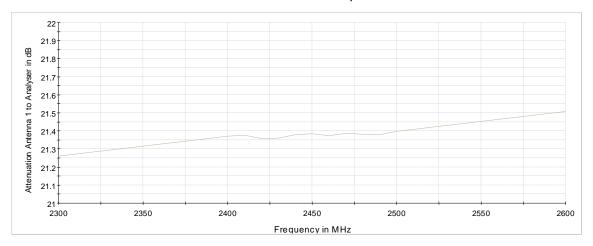


TS8997; Output Power

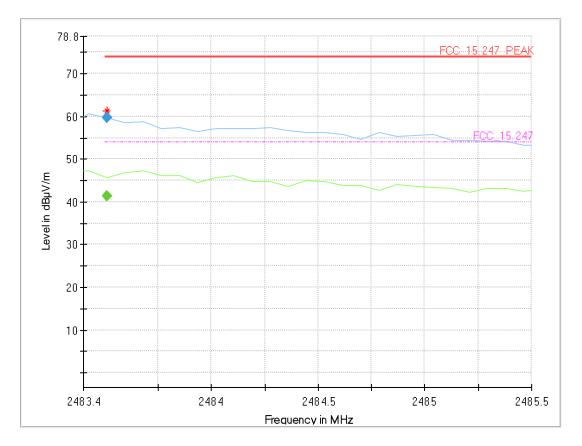

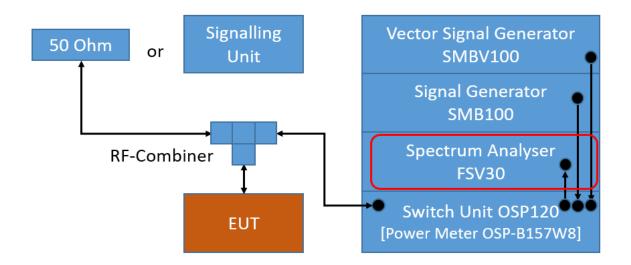

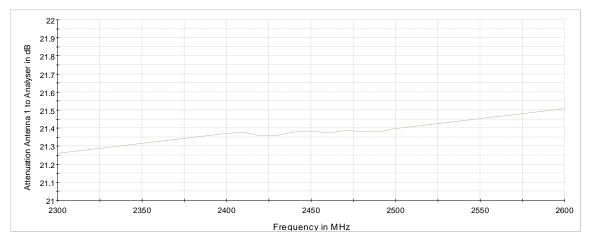
