Narrative and Explanation of Operation

This is a request for Special Temporary Authorization for the use of wireless Microphone and video (TV Pickup) channels at Circuit of the Americas Motor Speedway near Austin, Texas for the purpose of conducting video and audio production at the 24 hour Hankook automobile race event. The event is scheduled to begin on 9 November and end 12 November, 2017.

Requested are three specific channels in the UHF Television band; two channels at 419 and 429 MHz; a single transmitter to operate in the band 454-455 MHz and a single video transmitter to operate on a single video bandwidth channel somewhere in the band 2210-2250 MHz.

This STA is necessary because the applicant is a German company with no ability or need to obtain regular licenses for this one event in the United States. The bands and channels proposed have been recently approved for the Formula One automobile race at this same venue, occurring three weeks before the instant proposed STA period.

Should any reported interference occur, all operation on the applied-for channels will cease immediately and not resume unless and until the interference is resolved to the satisfaction of the complainant licensee.
