To Operate in the, 150-160MHz VHF band and the 430-470MHz UHF Band to
Provide Communications for TV Coverage in the Richmond, Virginia area.

3G Wireless, LLC hereby requests Special Temporary Authority (STA) to operate in the 450 – 512MHz UHF Band pursuant to Section 21.25 of the Commission's Rules. 3G Wireless, LLC requests that the Commission grant it special temporary authority to operate on the frequencies centered on 151.29375 MHz, 160.300 MHz, 160.350MHz, 160.575MHz, 161.300MHz, 439.800MHz, 430.137MHz, 430.162MHz, 440.200MHz, 445.425MHz, 445.400MHz, 443.550MHz, 447.637MHz, 460.500MHz and 460.400MHz with a 12.5MHz bandwidth from September 12, 2015 through September 28, 2015 with intermittent usage. As explained below, 3G Wireless, LLC is filing an STA request for communications for the live television transmission of "UCI Road World Championship" road bicycle race. 3G Wireless submits that there are extraordinary circumstances warranting a grant of the STA request.

Medalist Sports has contracted 3G Wireless, LLC to provide the necessary RF for communications during the live transmission of this event. Due to the extreme frequency congestion in the Richmond, Virginia area, coupled with the added congestion from traditional Television and News coverage of the special event, 3G Wireless, LLC requests the use of channels in the 150-160MHz VHF band and 430 – 470MHz UHF Band. A complete map of the race stages can be found on the UCI Road World Championships web-site, <http://richmond2015.com/>.

3G Wireless, LLC certifies that the operation of the requested channels for the purposes specified herein will not cause interference to any established stations.

Grant of the instant request for STA in the 150-160MHz VHF band and 430 – 470MHz UHF band would serve the public interest by enabling 3G Wireless, LLC to supply the requested remote communications coverage for this event. The proposed service would enhance coverage of the event by providing on the spot communication from mobile locations along the race route that would not otherwise be available to the Production Company.
