Dear Mr. Burtle:

In accordance with my conversation of October 11, 2006 with Mr. Serafini, I am writing this e-mail to request expedited processing of the above-referenced experimental license application filed with the FCC on behalf of 4-D Security Solutions, Inc.

Specifically, In August 2006, I spoke to you regarding the project that our firm was handling for our client 4-D Security Solutions, Inc., that is being funded by the US Department of Homeland Security. You indicated that your office will review experimental license applications that are related to the Department of Homeland Security on a preferential basis. You also indicated that once the pertinent information is collected and the application is filed with the FCC, we should notify Mr. Doug Young of its pendency.

I spoke to Mr. Young about the above-referenced application who, in turn, introduced me to Mr. Serafini.
