AFTRCC states that the band 2385-2390 MHz is designated exclusively for flight test telemetry and requests that the Commission exclude this band from this authorization. AT&T has no objection to the modification requested by AFTRCC. AT&T respectfully requests the Commission to grant the requested license renewal as modified in accordance with this request.
