You should file a separate experimental license request for each specific use case instead of filing everything under one experimental license. For example 2021-2022 RAN vendor testbeds advanced feature testing should be a separate experimental license request and the pending tests in 6 GHz WiFi 6E should be a separate request, and the Proof of Concept trials essential to identify the technologies, use cases, and innovations should be a standalone request. That way if one of the use case/frequency is delayed then it doesn't impact your other use cases.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of November 29, 2021 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
