
This letter is to advise the Commission of our concurrence in the experimental license application of AeroVironment, Inc., which proposes to use 454.675-454.975 MHz and 459.675-459.975 MHz for the remainder of calendar year 2020 under authorization WJ2XUP at the technical parameters set forth in the application, including flight at an altitude up to 80,000 feet at a site located in Truth or Consequences, NM and for laboratory tests in Simi Valley, CA and Moorpark, CA.

Aura Network Systems OpCo, LLC, which leases the above-listed frequencies associated with WPON853, KUO576 and KWU510 from licensee A2G Communications LLC, and AeroVironment have agreed to coordinate on how the frequency shall be used and/or shared during this concurrence period.
