**Subject:** Amended STA 1088-EX-ST-2020 Concurrence with Comment Amended

NTIA concurs with the FCC STA request on behalf of Anduril Industries for Camp Lejeune during the period 22 July 2020 thru 10 August 2020, with the following comment(s):

1. The proponent must be aware that the frequency band 24.45-24.65 GHz is primary allocated for radionavigation purposes such as Detect and Avoid (DAA). Radiolocation operations such as perimeter defense, drone interdiction and counter-UAS are secondary and shall not interference with future radionavigation operations. While the FAA acknowledges the FCC Waiver DA 19-556 allowing Echodyne secondary operations, any modifications of this grant to include radionavigation operations (such as a data feed to FAA for separation of aircraft or air traffic control) with radiolocation operations must be reviewed by FAA on a national level.
