Below is the information regarding part 0.459 (b) Questions.

(1) Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought;

-Information withholding details of experimental radios and any further information of said radios.

(2) Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission;

-The submitted document "Description of research project.pdf" is desired to be held confidential

(3) Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged;

-The information of the radios are geared towards military applications, under which this project is part of a military contract.

(4) Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition;

-This could have an impact on Department of Defense and it's work if information of the radios were made public.

(5) Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm;

-This application is for testing purposes. We don't want other entities or foreign governments to know what or how we are testing the device.
