**Assignees Relation to Assignor**

Aprize Satellite, Inc. (“Aprize”) is the licensee of AprizeSat-9 satellite, File Number 0827-EX-PL-2014, Call Sign WH2XNU. Aprize, as assignor, wishes to assign its experimental authorization to exactEarth, Ltd. exactEarth, as assignee, wishes to obtain authorization to control the use and operation of AprizeSat-9 by accepting such assignment.

AprizeSat-9 carries an advanced experimental Automatic Identification System (“AIS”) payload for a ship tracking and data collection. exactEarth Ltd, a Canadian company, has purchased the AprizeSat satellite with the intention of carrying out experiments that will determine the feasibility of developing and commercializing technology that will enable low power AIS units typically found on smaller commercial tonnage and leisure vessels to be tracked from space, thereby enabling global tracking. exactEarth has the financial and technical qualifications to carry on its AIS experimental program, which will be conducted in such a manner and at such time as to preclude harmful interference to any authorized station.

The only change to the current FCC authorization of AprizeSat-9 is the transfer of control from Aprize Satellite Inc. to exactEarth Ltd.
