Please submit a progress report describing the experimental nature of your testing and justification for continued experimentation under Part 5. Also indicate if this license is being used for any commercial contracts and service. Commercial operation should be conducted under Part 25. You may need to consider transition to Part 25 licensing and should consult with the FCC International Bureau regarding commercial authorization. Finally, NASA has objected to continued operation in the federal 2200-2290 MHz band. Rule Section 5.83 states that a Part 5 license does not confer any right to conduct an activity of a continuing nature. If this license is renewed, we will need to remove those frequencies from the license and you will need to stop any testing on that frequency band.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of September 28, 2017 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
