By linking this contract number with this application, our competition and adversaries can easily identify our technology implementation and act maliciously.

#### 4.) Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm

Inclusion of this information can be utilized to identify the hardware and frequencies of operation along with the contract number. This allows for an extrapolation of a contract solution, which can lead to security concerns for the Department of Defense. This also provides our competition with an advantage on current and future contracts.

Area-I takes countless precautions to protect its intellectual property, one precaution being to release minimal public information. Specifically, Area-I strives to maintain the trade secrets utilized to perform our missions. This is often done by mitigating where sensitive information can be accessed, especially implementation details.

The contract information along with our name is publicly available, but none of this is linked to a specific technology implementation. Area-I would like to prevent the contract number from being accessible via the STA.
