The FCC's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau recommends against using any part of the 4940-4990 MHz band: "The STA should not use the 4940 MHz to 4990 MHz band because Aurora Flight Sciences did not provide information that coordination with Public Safety licenses in the test area was completed or interference will not be caused to public safety entities licensed in this band. In addition, rule 90.1205(c) prohibits aeronautical mobile operations in this band.

Can you reduce your request to 4.9-4.94 GHz or can you show evidence of coordination with public safety entities?

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of May 12, 2017 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
