

**Autotel Race Radio**  
**Application for Special Temporary Authority**  
**File No. 1576-EX-ST-2017**  
**Creventic 24 Hours Circuit of the Americas Automobile Race (Hankook)**

This application for Special Temporary Authority is submitted by Autotel Race Radio, a telecommunications company located in the United Kingdom. The application seeks several VHF channels, simplex and duplex, for operational communications for two race teams (the Brookspeed and Slidesports race teams) which will have crews and race cars participating in the Hankook Creventic 24-hour Automobile Race at the Circuit of the Americas Race Track near Austin, Texas from November 10 through 12, 2017.

These channels have been reviewed against the Commission's ULS database and have been found to be unlikely to cause interference to any co-channel or adjacent channel licensee. Nevertheless, should any interference be reported to a licensee or authorized user during the race event, operation on the affected channel or channels will cease and will not resume unless and until all interference has been resolved to the satisfaction of the complainant.

The equipment to be used in each case includes Kenwood portable transceivers, a single Icom repeater and a single Kenwood mobile. The portables and mobile will operate at 5 watts and the Icom repeater at 10 watts. All emissions will be 11K2F3E.
