Mr. Lando and Ms. Nguyen:

Pursuant to prior discussions with Mr. Lando, BAE Systems has filed the attached application under File No. 0205-EX-CM-2021 to modify the WJ2XXQ license to change the contract on the license and revise the contract special condition, and to update to the emission designator for 1025-1035 MHz and 1087-1093 MHz to "P0N";.

As reflected in the Exhibit to the application, Mr. Lando in 2020 confirmed that additional FAA coordination through WebFCR would not be required for these modifications – see email from Mr. Lando below and in the Exhibit.
