As a follow-up to our recent discussions, and in connection with BAE Systems' pending modification of Experimental Station WF2XAM under File No. 0283-EX-CM-2020, please note:

- Submission of WebFCR FAA Coordination Request for 99 Frequencies within 228.8-328.6 MHz (TRK 210157)

As you requested, BAE Systems has submitted to the WebFCR portal a request for coordination of the 99 specified frequencies within 228.8-328.6 MHz.

As we discussed, the WebFCR submission was identified as the 228.8-328.6 MHz band – but the attached narrative lists the 99 specific frequencies for which FAA coordination is actually sought.

As we discussed, the intention of this approach is to avoid having to obtain 99 separate NGT numbers for these discrete frequencies, and to avoid having to amend the application to list all 99 separate frequencies.

Please keep us posted regarding FAA's review of this submission, or if you have any questions.
