Good afternoon.

As you know, back in July SiriusXM issued its consent to the operations of BAE Systems as authorized by the FCC in the Experimental Special Temporary Authority (STA) under call sign WK9XBR. Please see attached and below.

The STA (scan attached) is scheduled to expire on February 1, 2017. However, because BAE Systems will require the ability to operate on these frequencies beyond the 2/1 expiration date, BAE Systems has filed the attached application for a 2 year experimental license which includes the same frequencies that were subject to the prior consent. Please see attached scan of the application for a 2 year experimental license, pending under File No. 0329-EX-CN-2016.
