On behalf of BellSouth Personal Communications, Inc. ("BPCI"), transmitted herewith in duplicate is an Application For Renewal Of Radio Station License In Specified Services (47 CFR parts 5, 21, 22, 23, 25 and 101) on FCC Form 405.

By the enclosed application, BPCI seeks renewal of Experimental Radio Station License KA2XBT, File No. 5113-EX-R-98. The license is due to expire on March 1, 2000.
