USARMY.WSMR.IMCOM-SUP04.CENTRAL.LIST.DODAF(AT)MAIL.MIL.
IF OPERATIONS ARE DAILY, THEN WEEKLY SCHEDULE IS PREFERRED.
PLEASE INCLUDE PLANNED DATES, START AND STOP TIMES, AND NOTIFY DOD-AFC WSMR OF ANY CANCELLATIONS.

This is the standard coordination process which BNSF has been following for their testing requirements in New Mexico.

Yesterday, I received an e-mail from the FCC that they had added these notes, so your FCC license should be forthcoming.
