The State of California (State) is requesting a modification to existing license WK2XBA, located at the Caribou Power House Telemetry site in Plumas County California. The State is requesting a frequency change at this location; replace 401.7895 MHz with 401.9575 MHz. The telemetry site is part of a larger system operated by the State which includes but is not limited to WA2XAJ, WC2XOB, and WI2XDU. The purpose of the site is to monitor water level, water temperature, wind speed, and other data for the area. The data is transmitted to the GOES satellite and is collected by the State's Department of Water Resources.
