RENEWAL EXHIBIT

CCO Fiberlink, LLC ("Charter"), a limited liability company and subsidiary of Charter Communications, Inc., is seeking a one-year renewal to its experimental market trial license WJ2XZT using the same technical parameters in its original application.

Should the trial prove successful, Charter potentially intends to transition its operations and any authorized equipment to General Authorized Access ("GAA") or into the Initial Commercial Deployment ("ICD") under the 3.5 GHz authority outlined in the 3.5 GHz First Report and Order and subsequent public notice,¹ working in conjunction with Federated Wireless, Inc. As a result, if the trial is successful, participants potentially would be offered the opportunity to transition from a free trial to a retail service operating under GAA or ICD, and those opting to subscribe would retain their certified installed equipment. If unsuccessful or if a trial participant opts not to accept this service, all equipment will be recovered consistent with the experimental service requirements. Any formerly-experimental equipment that is identical to equipment that has received equipment authorization during the trial period will receive proper labeling as required under the Commission's rules and participants opting into the GAA or ICD service would be allowed to retain their properly labeled and authorized equipment.
