Mr. Sangani,

Caltech is in receipt of the OET's request for additional information. We are working on the following:

ODAR - will be submitted by Momentus, which is the satellite that the Caltech transmitter will ride on in orbit. Because the Caltech experiment is not its own satellite, but it is a hosted payload, it does not have the independence for a unique ODAR. We will provide the Momentus file number as soon as their application is on file.

The ITU Cost recovery letter will be submitted shortly. A draft is on file as a supplemental exhibit.

We are working on the polar antenna plots.

We will submit the NOAA letter that determined that NO imagery licensing is required.

We will start working on the SpaceCap filing next week.

These items all require time and attention. On behalf of Caltech, I am formally requesting additional time beyond May 14, 2021 to complete the submissions. In my experience, we will need at least an additional 30 days, because of the complexity of SpaceCap.
