Uplink/Downlink 437,270 MHz

You have indicated a launch date of September 2013. Please advise us of final date for the launch when this becomes available as well as if there are other satellites using amateur allocations so that any possible interference can be prevented.

Please note that all frequencies in the amateur satellite service are shared frequencies. We have attempted to make the best possible selection for your project.
