Capella Space Corp. (“Capella”) requests that the Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”) modify Capella’s experimental license authorization of the Capella-3 satellite granted earlier this month (FCC File No. 0029-EX-CM-2020) to add the Capella-4 satellite to the experimental authorization.

The Capella-4 satellite is identical to the Capella-3 satellite in its radio frequency use and will operate in the same orbital plane and therefore with the same orbital parameters as Capella-3.

Given the Capella-4 satellite is scheduled to launch in December 2020 on a SpaceX rideshare mission together with Capella-3, Capella respectfully requests that OET expeditiously grant this modification to add the Capella-4 satellite to the experimental authorization prior to its scheduled December launch.
