This letter notifies the Commission that the referenced approved *pro forma* transfer of indirect control of CellBlox Acquisitions, LLC ("CellBlox") from Securus Technologies, Inc. ("Transferor") to Securus Technologies, LLC ("Transferee") was effective as of December 31, 2019. Although we understand that consummation notices are not required for the transfer of control of spectrum lessees, this notification also applies to the *pro forma* transfer of control of lessee CellBlox under certain *de facto* transfer spectrum leases (ULS File No. 0008877373) and spectrum manager leases (ULS File Nos. 0008896175 and 0008896189). CellBlox will be filing an updated ownership disclosure in the Universal Licensing System using FCC Form 602 to reflect its current ownership.
