DRS Soneticom is a provider of signal processing systems and solutions. Our customers, which include commercial customers as well as various U.S. government agencies, procure our solutions to process, analyze and extract a variety of characteristic information on transmitted radio signals.

DRS Soneticom requests authorization to operate base station and mobile station equipment described in our application on a non-interfering basis. Said equipment is manufactured by a provider of commercial wireless infrastructure and mobile equipment. This equipment has not been and will not be modified by DRS or another party from the original manufacturer's specifications. The equipment is typically intended to be operated by service providers of wireless communications and DRS intends to operate the equipment in a similar manner; however, with the following exceptions; 1. The purpose for operation is for collecting data on known transmitted signals from both the base station and mobile stations that are affected by a typical signal environment and not to provide wireless service, and 2. Operation is for limited periods of time, but on an on-going basis as DRS requires additional data collection for analysis to improve our product or to demonstrate product capabilities.

Our analysis of data collected from equipment operation requested in our application will enable DRS with the ability to improve our products and to provide solutions that are of interest to our customers.
