Message:

1. Submit a narrative statement describing in detail the program of research and experimentation proposed, the specific objectives sought to be accomplished; and how the program of experimentation has a reasonable promise of contribution to the development, extension, or expansion, or use of the radio art, or is along lines not already investigated.
2. You have marked an exhibit as confidential. You must submit an item-by-item justification for the confidentiality request to answer the nine subsections of Part 0.459(b) of the FCC's rules. All non-confidential material must be separated from the confidential material and must be viewable by the public, as must the confidentiality justification.
3. Submit a justification for the large number of units.
4. Submit a justification for a nationwide license. The FCC does not like to approve nationwide use of an experimental license if the goals of the experiment can be accomplished in a much smaller area.
5. This application looks very similar to 0742-EX-CN-2020, except for the number of units. Why couldn't this have been filed as a modification of station WL2XGD?

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of October 29, 2020 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
