Dear Sir:

As per our recent discussion, attached you will find a letter from DISH Wireless L.L.C. ("DISH") regarding its intention to request Special Temporary Authority ("STA") from the Federal Communications Commission's Office of Engineering and Technology to conduct certain equipment testing in the Yuma, Arizona market area on the frequencies 1695-1710 MHz (FCC Call Signs WQWQ972 and WQWQ973). SNR Wireless LicenseCo, LLC ("SNR") is the licensee for these frequencies and has agreed to consent to the STA. DISH's letter provides assurance to DoD and related agencies (Department of the Navy and US Marine Corps) that it will commit to certain operating conditions and procedures to insure that its operations under the STA will not cause harmful interference to military operations.

As we agreed on our last telephonic conference call, SNR is also prepared to submit this letter as well as DISH's letter along with a description of the operations through the NTIA AWS-3 Coordination portal as a way of testing and validating the efficacy of the ITS portal.

Based on DISH's assurances and commitment, our hope is that DoD and the relevant agencies will consent to this STA and provide immediate guidance to NTIA and FCC of such consent so that the FCC can grant the STA. In the meantime, SNR will work in regular order with DoD and the relevant agencies to test the ITS Coordination Portal.

I look forward to hearing from you and appreciate your timely consideration of SNR's request.
