Submitted herewith on behalf of our client, EastWest Communications, Inc. (EastWest), is a request for reinstatement and modification of the above-captioned facility. EastWest's experimental authorization for the above-referenced facility expired on February 1, 1991. For your reference, we have enclosed a copy of the authorization.
