Request for Special Temporary Authority

On behalf of ESPN Productions, Inc. ("ESPN"), this letter requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to operate in UHF frequencies 482–488 MHz in order to coordinate event emergencies, transportation, security and safety conditions in connection with ESPN's live coverage of the 2015 NFL Draft to be held in Chicago, Illinois from April 24<sup>th</sup> through May 4, 2015. ESPN has monitored the requested frequencies to insure that there is no interference with local licensed users.

The NFL Draft is an annual event attracting an extremely large spectator crowd. Crowd control, potential safety hazards and the need for effective radio communications for coordination are necessary. Frequency distribution will be utilized for operations, security, crowd management and first aid coordination's. Operations on the proposed frequencies will be monitored on a 24-hour basis, and it is understood that authorization is secondary in nature. There will be (400) UHF 4 watt handheld radios utilized along with (6) 20-watt trunking repeaters to provide adequate radio coverage of the event area.

ESPN has coordinated this use of this spectrum with the SBE Frequency Coordinator of record for the Chicago area and has received approval.
