Hello,

I received the following questions: Your exhibit states, "The experimental license will enable tests of the EchoGuard radar to support the FAA in evaluating counter-unmanned aircraft systems (cUAS) equipment." 1) Are you jamming, spoofing, and/or performing electronic attack? Yes/No 2) What is the specific application for your frequency request?

- 1) No. The EchoGuard is a radar system, operating in the K-band frequency (24.45-24.65 GHz), providing 3D (azimuth, elevation, range) situational awareness information. It does not provide electronic attack capability.
- 2) The frequencies requested will only be used for radiolocation in support of the FAA's sensor evaluation to protect airports from rogue drone flights. The EchoGuard has an FCC ID (2ANLB-MESASSR00053) and has been granted a waiver for radiolocation.
