1. The requested frequency bands are listed as 1850-1990 and 1970-1988 kHz. Is this experimental request for PCS equipment, in which case the frequency units should be MHz? 1970-1988 is a subset of 1850-1990, with the same ERP. What is the reason for two listings? There also is no bandwidth and emission data for 1970-1988 kHz. Please fix if this row is still necessary.
2. The only transmit equipment listed is a base station, yet there appears to be both base and mobile frequency bands listed (if this is indeed the PCS band). Also, 1910-1930 MHz is designated for low-power unlicensed PCS operations. Please explain these discrepancies.
3. You have requested a three-year license term. Request for terms longer than the standard two years requires written justification.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of March 22, 2005 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
