## Response:

Detailed planning in installing and configuring (including spectrum Sweeping and Scanning for interference) of the radio antennas to eliminate any harmful interference to the incumbent operator in this band, including the Protected Fixed Satellite Service Earth Stations can be achieved by a combination of reducing RF (Radio Frequency) power, directing the antenna away from the Fixed Satellite Service Earth Stations and tilting or adjusting the antenna to reduce RF (Radio Frequency) coverage.

In addition, Ericsson staff will also identify FSS earth station licensees in the area and will be ready to reach out to them if any coordination efforts are necessary to further ensure no harmful interference occurs.
