



APPLICATION EXHIBIT – Application Dismissed – FORM 442

Two Whom It May Concern,

This exhibit is the explanation for the dismissed-without prejudice Form 442 application that was received by a prior colleague when applying for an experimental license for Ford Motor Company. The dismissal occurred because of error in selection of the proper Form 442. My colleague previously selected the “program” experimental license, which resulted in the application being subjected to Subpart E ‘Program Experimental Radio License’, and as specifically cited by the letter, Rule parts 5.302 and 5.304 regarding real property and control of the devices.

Selection of the “program” experimental license was due to a lack of understanding of the various versions of Form 442. It is now our understanding that a “conventional” experimental license is most appropriate for our development and testing needs, and therefore also not restricted to the same Subpart restrictions defined in Subpart E.
