1. You are the first amateur to request the 470-495 kHz band, while somewhere near 30 have requested 505-510 kHz. What are you doing that the rest of the amateur community isn't?
2. All other requests in the 505-515 kHz band have been limited to 505-510 kHz because of the aeronautical radionavigation allocation in 510-535 kHz. Can your request be limited to 505-510 kHz? If not, let me know and I will have to give you instructions on pre-coordination procedures with the FAA regional office.
