NTIA tabled 1395-1400 MHz and 1427-1432 MHz because airborne operations are prohibited in those bands. The 1435-1509.833 MHz band was agreed to by AFTRCC. You changed your frequency request to the single, very wide 1435-2110 MHz band. This is an increase in spectrum from a total of 85 MHz to a new total of 675 MHz. You would need to get a new AFTRCC approval. Also, it is highly unlikely that your wide request will be approved operating at 13,000 feet altitude. You will most certainly be rejected in aeronautical radionavigation bands and various radio astronomy bands. Amend your frequency request taking these facts into consideration.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of June 30, 2021 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
