Your frequency request is very broad. You need to justify the entire spectrum that you actually need. For instance, 10.68-10.7 GHz cannot be authorized by the Experimental Licensing Branch because it is strictly allocated to the radio astronomy service. Also any use of 5000-5250 MHz or 9000-9200 MHz will require coordination with the appropriate Federal Aviation Administration regional office. Return to our electronic filing site at <https://gulfoss2.fcc.gov/oetcf/els/index.cfm> and amend your frequency request accordingly or submit a justification for use of the entire 5-15 GHz band.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of June 19, 2007 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
