The FCC's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau is concerned with possible interference to low-power mobile operations of many public safety licensees. They are insisting on you getting consent of all the attached entities in 806-821 MHz before they will concur on an approval of your STA request. Your only other choice is to withdraw your request for this band.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of November 12, 2013 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
