This is in direct conflict with FCC Rule 5.85(c): "Frequency assignments will be made only on the condition that harmful interference will not be caused to any station operating in accordance with the Table of Frequency Allocation of part 2 of this chapter." We cannot knowingly approve of something that is likely to cause interference to TV stations. Please explain if this is not your intention.

- 2. Your frequency request is very broad. You have asked for 244 MHz of spectrum. State the absolute minimum amount of spectrum you need.
- 3. Confirm that you only need to operate for four months.
