Is the Rome location necessary as part of an STA request for a demo that you wish to start on July 23? Or is the Rome location part of some longer-term testing? If the Rome testing isn't needed by the July 23 timeframe and if it is intended to last more than six months, then the change in power and radius should be filed as a modification of the existing Rome license on Form 442. Form 442 should be used for testing that will last longer than six months and STAs should be filed for testing that will last for less than six months.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of July 08, 2016 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
