Some of the newly suggested frequencies are probably going to have the same problems as the previous ones that NTIA objected to. For instance, 1691.5-1696.5 MHz is completely within a Meteorological Aids and Satellite Band. The same is true for the first 3.5 MHz of 1696.5-1701.5 MHz. The rest of that band, the entire 1701.5-1706.5 MHz band and the first 3.5 MHz of 1706.5-1711.5 MHz are also in a Meteorological Satellite band, though there is also a Fixed allocation there. However, fixed use in that band is caveatted by a footnote to the U.S. Table of Allocations that says federal fixed stations may be authorized ONLY if no spectrum is available in 1755-1850 MHz. This means there is a SLIGHT chance that NTIA won't object to use in that band. The rest of your request falls in a non-government Fixed and Mobile band that you could probably get permission to use if you coordinate with any Advanced Wireless Services licensees in the area.

I suggest that you go back and look at the Table of Allocations in 47CFR2.106 and follow NTIA's suggestion to select bands allocated for fixed and mobile use, preferably spectrum allocated to the federal government if you plan on using this equipment long-term. If you will only be using this equipment short-term and have plans to move to different frequency bands in the future, then you may also suggest non-government bands for this STA request. When you have selected new frequencies, also suggest a new start date that is AT LEAST two weeks after the date that you re-submit a new frequency list because I will have to re-coordinate the application with both NTIA and my FCC bureau coordination POCs.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of March 05, 2010 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
