Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 1, 2005, Hughes Network Systems, LLC (“HNS”) was authorized to conduct testing of new satellite transceiver equipment that HNS manufactures using four segments of the L-band on an Inmarsat-3 satellite (see File Number 0068-EX-RR-2005, Call Sign WD2XJU). On November 16, 2005, HNS received OET authority to test the same equipment on the Inmarsat 4 recently launched over the Atlantic Ocean (File No. 0137-EX-ML-2005, Call Sign WD2XJU). On December 23, 2005, HNS notified the Office of Engineering and Technology of the specific L-band spectrum segments that were required for the RBGAN equipment testing authorized under File No. 0137-EX-ML-2005.

HNS has recently been advised by Inmarsat that the specific L-band frequency segments that HNS may use for its RBGAN equipment testing on Inmarsat-4 have been adjusted and are slightly different than those notified in our letter of December 23, 2005. As a result, HNS would like to correct the record and advises that, within the frequencies authorized in November, it intends to utilize the following specific frequency segments for its RBGAN equipment test program:

1627.1 – 1627.7 MHz
1639.2 – 1639.3 MHz
1639.3 – 1639.5 MHz
1642.5 – 1642.7 MHz
1642.8 – 1643.0 MHz
1643.9 – 1644.3 MHz
1646.5 – 1647.7 MHz
