## Reason for Modification Request Application 0160-EX-CM-2020

To accommodate the interruption of work on mission hardware due to the earthquakes in Puerto Rico and subsequently the Covid-19 pandemic, the PRCUNAR2 mission has been remanifested to SpaceX 22, for its launch as cargo to the ISS in March 2021. This will shift the deploy from ISS date to approximately June 2021, but the orbit, operation plan and radio characteristics remain the same. And the satellite is still expected to deorbit about 9 months after deploy, within the period of the original license 1007-EX-CN-2019, which ends June 1, 2022.

This modification is requested to notify FCC of the revised launch and deploy dates. The other mission parameters remain unchanged.
