Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, KeyW Corporation ("KeyW") hereby updates certain information in connection with the above-referenced application for a two-year experimental license to operate an experimental earth station ("KeyW Experimental Earth Station") and experimental satellite payload ("KeyW Experimental Payload").

Specifically, KeyW withdraws its request to operate the KeyW Experimental Payload. The KeyW Experimental Payload was recently authorized under Part 25 of the Commission's rules and is now included in Spire Global Inc.'s non-geostationary satellite orbit ("NGSO") satellite license. Accordingly, KeyW only requests experimental authority to operate the KeyW Experimental Earth Station with the Part 25-licensed KeyW payload. Finally, KeyW acknowledges and accepts the earth station coordination and notification conditions included in the *Spire License* and will ensure KeyW Experimental Earth Station operations are compliant with the applicable conditions.
