

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED TRANSACTION

L3 Security & Detection Systems, Inc. (the “Licensee”), holds the Experimental Special Temporary Authorization WP9XJM, which expires April 1, 2020 (the “STA”). As part of a currently proposed transaction, the current parent entity of the Licensee, L3 Technologies, Inc., has proposed to transfer control of the Licensee to Leidos, Inc. (“Transferee”), as set forth in the attached Form 703.

The transfer of control proposed herein will not result in any violation of the Act or any other applicable statutory provision. Moreover, the proposed transfer fully complies with all Commission rules and regulations and does not require any waivers. Transferee has the qualifications necessary to acquire control of the Licensee and the facilities authorized under the STA, and the Licensee holds no other FCC authorizations that require Commission approval prior to any consummation of the proposed transaction. Accordingly, the Parties respectfully submit that Commission approval of the proposed transaction would serve the public interest, convenience, and necessity, and prompt FCC grant of this application is respectfully requested.

In addition, and consistent with Section 5.61(c) of the Commission’s rules, the Licensee has recently filed an application for an experimental license in order to extend the operations previously authorized under the STA beyond the STA’s current deadline of April 1, 2020. *See* FCC File No. 0232-EX-CN-2020 (the “License Application”). As the License Application remains pending, the Licensee also requests, as part of the Commission’s review of the current transfer of control application, that the Commission also approve the transfer of control from the Transferor to the proposed Transferee of the License Application, or any license that results from the grant of the License Application. Because approval of the transfer of control involving the current STA (and any subsequent license that may supersede that STA) as part of the same transfer of control application would promote administrative efficiency, the proposed request is consistent with the public interest.
