Hello Behnam,

You asked the following question: "whether the equipment related to your [our] operation is for testing and experimentation of airborne radio altimeters"?

I would say no. However, altitude is one of the parameters that we are passing between the radios. The experiment will use GPS derived navigational data including altitude and it will transmit that data as telemetry data between the two radios.

The intent of the testing is to demonstrate whether the two Banshee radios can connect and successfully pass the telemetry data between the two aircrafts while they are practicing the steps that lead up to an airborne refueling operation without actually refueling.
