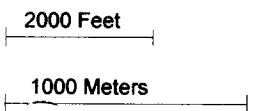


NEAREST AIRCRAFT LANDING AREA

Previously a World War II Naval Land Installation charged with the primary responsibility of German U-Boat surveillance, our airport has developed into one of the finest, state-of-the-art airports in Louisiana.

Our Level 1 FAA, V.F.R., non-radar tower is open 7 days a week from 6:00 am to 7:00 pm CST.

Two concrete intersecting runways provide for landing and departing aircraft. The north-south runway is the longest at 6,508' x 150' and is our full instrument landing system runway. The crosswind runway is 5,000' x 200' and is our non-precision approach runway. The FAA publishes 6 instrument approach procedures for the airport.

Our economic demography is strong, showing a 5.6% growth factor, the 2nd strongest in Louisiana. We are nationally ranked as one of the better places to live in the United States.
