This submission is a request for Special Temporary Authority (STA) by Lynk Global, Inc. (Lynk) for additional operations by our satellite *Lynk the World*, which was granted the call sign WQ9XDP under file number 2130-EX-ST-2019. This satellite commenced operations 13 May 2020. **This additional request is necessary due to COVID-19 travel restrictions.** Currently, Lynk has one approved testing site within the continental United States. This testing site is within Navajo Nation territory and cannot be accessed by non-residents. At the time of this filing, international travel is restricted and/or not recommended.

We have made a formal request for key sensitive information to be redacted from the public posting of the application and supporting documents. Pursuant to Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.457 and 0.459, the Commission may withhold from public inspection and accord confidential treatment to certain material related to this application. We have attached the details of this request in a separate document and have provided a public version of the STA application in which we have redacted information that qualifies as trade secrets and confidential information under Exception 4 of the Freedom of Information Act.
