

You will please find enclosed one copy of a completed FCC Form 702, Application for Assignment, with the required FCC Form 159 and License Processing Fees, \$2,250.00 (\$45.00/ 48 licenses, plus \$45.00/ 2 confidential requests for KK2XCJ and KO2XBQ), attached. This filing is being submitted by the Lockheed Martin Corporation as a result of the recently merger of the Martin Marietta Corporation and Lockheed Corporation and all related businesses, completed on March 15th 1995. We currently have Special Temporary Authorizations on file, submitted March 2nd, 1995, for all affected radio station authorizations for the two merging corporations. These STA's will cover operations of all systems until final approval of the attached applications by the FCC.

This filing is being submitted as a Mass Filing at this due to size and complexity of the merger and the affected radio station authorizations involved. All administrative data affected by the merger has been updated to reflect the new licensee, Lockheed Martin Corporation. Since all technical data for the affected licenses remains unchanged, it is understood no MRFAC coordination is required, at this time.
