With respect to the request for coordination of the band segment 2390-2395 MHz, AFTRCC does not coordinate that segment, because it is not used for flight test telecom purposes. The band segment is co-primary with the Amateur Radio Service and because AFTRCC was unable years ago to arrive at a sharing agreement with the Amateur Radio operators, flight test operations do not occur in that band. In many years of applications for the band 2390-2400 MHz, the Commission has never asked for coordination with AFTRCC in the band 2390-2395 MHz for that reason. Nothing has changed which should justify the requirement now. The band is routinely used for video production purposes by various entities including the instant applicant.
